Tracer Sayonara™

Sayonara is the triathlon industry's first swimskin to use the patented Yamamoto Biorubber Mark III fabric, a lightweight super composite skin (SCS) made of Titanium alloy for thermoregulation and a hydrogen-bonded surface to reduce drag and maximize water repellency.

Material

Yamamoto Biorubber Mark III is made of an elastic knit construction to provide flexibility and balance to evenly support the swimmer's body in all directions.

Fabric Technology

Three-Layer SCS Fabrication Structure (only 0.3 mm thick):



- Outer Surface: Limestone based Micro-Honeycomb structure forms a ball-bearing effect of water molecules for maximum water repellency at a low drag co-efficient of .021, a decrease of 34% over the existing Yamamoto fabric on the market.
- Mid-Layer: Flexible Titanium alloy contours to the natural shape of the swimmer to reduce stress and muscle fatigue.
- Inner Layer: Soft, lightweight single knit stretch has a water absorption ratio of only 0.5%.



Key Features

- Core Control Panel stabilizes the swimmer against rotational forces to maintain a proper body position for maximum stroke efficiency.
- Zoned ventilation panels are strategically placed on the legs and rear with enhanced cooling properties.
- Durable, coiled zipper with Velcro closure holds fast to provide a secure fit.
- Soft, reinforced neckline reduces chaffing and prevents excess water build-up.
- Extended pull cord assists with smooth transitions.
- Tapered, flexible leg grippers prevent chaffing and allows for quick removal.
- Four-way flat lock seaming offers athlete the greatest range of motion.

Sayonara is designed as a high performance swimskin technology for non-wetsuit triathlons when the water temperature is greater than 78 degrees, but less than 84 degrees Fahrenheit.
